

He was instrumental in improving the religious education program and getting more parental involvement in it.

One of the best things people talk of is that achen is always approachable and he gives each of us the same level of attention.

Another feather in his hat is surely the popularity of our English Mass. The dedication he showed to master the new and peculiar Mass bore wonderful results and now it is one of the services with the most attendance.

Saji achen has helped emphasize the importance of adoration in our lives: his well-known 40-hour adoration in Chicago has been continued in our Houston church as well. It has positively affected the lives of all the parishioners. Additionally, he also holds an hour of daily adoration prior to the daily Qurbana and full day adoration on Fridays with special hours of adoration for Youth.

Other activities that Saii achen has done that has boosted the morale of his parishioners include: the pilgrimages he has taken along with the parishioners to Holy Land and Europe, improvement/ beatification of the church entrance, expansion of the parking lots around the church, installation of 14 stations of the cross around the premises of the church, installation of Kodimaram in front of the church, Theology class, etc. He also helped the church start this bi-weekly parish bulletin that promotes the current and upcoming church activities that has been widely acclaimed among the parishioners.

Another factor that has increased the participation of the parishioners in the Church is the rejuvenation of the "kudarayogams".

However, Saji-achen's enthusiasm and ideas on incorporating the different kudarayogams into the different church activities proved quite successful. Church decoration and cleaning is assigned to different kudarayogams each month. When there was no one to undertake the main Thirunnal, Achen suggested that the kudarayogams take turns every year to host the main feast. This idea was met with overwhelming support and tremendous coordination among the members of individual kudarayogams

There is no need for us to talk more of the way achen takes care of the Parish however his equal enthusiasm when it comes to matters of the society was a breath of fresh air.

During the time when some of our parishioners were having hardships after hurricane Harvey, achen's leadership and willingness to get his hands dirty and help in the cleanup was inspirational.

We are sad to lose a great Shepherd however wish him all the best in his new Parish.
