

The Importance of Bringing Children to Our Syro-Malabar English Qurbana

Dear Beloved Parishioners,

I want to address an important matter close to my heart – the spiritual nurturing of our children within our unique community.

Our Knanaya heritage is a precious gift, one that we are called to cherish and pass on to future generations. I urge all young parents to consider the following reasons for bringing your children to our Syro-Malabar English Qurbana every Sunday even when we do not have catechism:

Our Syro-Malabar liturgy, with roots tracing back to Bishop Urha Mar Joseph in 345 AD, is a living legacy. This liturgical tradition is a precious heritage we are privileged to continue. By participating regularly, our children become stewards of this rich tradition, ensuring its vibrancy for generations to come. It is our right and responsibility to perpetuate this tradition through our children.


