THE CATHOLIC CONCEPT OF DATING

What is Permissible and Not Permissible

From a Catholic standpoint, dating should be a pure and respectful interaction between individuals. Some permissible behaviors include:

- Mutual Respect: Treating each other with dignity and kindness.
- Group Activities: Engaging in social activities that do not isolate the couple but involve community.

However, certain behaviors are not permissible:

- Deceptive Relationships: Entering into a relationship without the intention of discerning marriage, or leading someone on, is ethically wrong and contrary to the purpose of dating.

To our dear parents, I urge you to take an active role in guiding your children through the dating process. Teach them about the value of chastity, the importance of setting boundaries, and the significance of seeking a partner who shares their faith and values. Your wisdom and example are crucial in helping them navigate this journey with integrity.

To the youth, remember that dating is not a game but a serious step towards discerning your future vocation. Respect yourself and your partner by upholding the values of our faith. Let Christ be your guide, and do not be afraid to stand up for what is right, even when it is difficult.

Let us all, as a community, pray for our young people, that they may grow in virtue and love, and that their relationships may reflect the love of Christ. May the Holy Family of Nazareth be their model and inspiration.



- · CLASSES WILL BEGIN ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 25TH


