



## VICAR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary on September 8th, we are reminded of the profound role that Mary plays in the history of salvation. The birth of Mary is a cause of great joy for the Church, for through her, the dawn of our redemption was set in motion. Tradition holds that Mary was born to Saints Joachim and Anne, a devout and elderly couple who had long been childless. Their faith and perseverance in prayer were rewarded with the birth of Mary, who was destined to become the Mother of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

The Protoevangelium of James, an early Christian writing from the second century, gives us a beautiful account of Mary's birth and the dedication of her life to God from a young age. Although this text is not part of the canonical scriptures, it has significantly influenced the Church's understanding and celebration of Mary's life. According to this tradition, Mary was consecrated to God and lived a life of purity and devotion, setting an example for all Christians to follow.

As we celebrate the Nativity of Mary, we also look forward to the coming Feast of the Nativity of Jesus. In many Eastern Christian traditions, this period is marked by an eight-day fast, known as the "Nativity Fast." This fast is a time of spiritual preparation, echoing the period of Advent in the Western Church. It invites us to purify our hearts, seek reconciliation, and focus on the true meaning of Christmas - the birth of our Savior.

The tradition of the Nativity Fast emphasizes the importance of fasting not just as a physical discipline but as a spiritual one. It is a time to draw closer to God, to increase our prayers, and to extend our love and charity to those in need. By abstaining from certain foods and distractions, we create space in our lives to welcome Christ more fully into our hearts and homes.

## VICAR'S MESSAGE

As we participate in these sacred traditions, let us remember that the feasts of the Church are not just commemorations of past events but are living realities that draw us deeper into the mystery of God's love. Mary's birth is a sign of hope, and her life of obedience and faith is an example for all of us. Let us also embrace the spirit of the Nativity Fast, whether by fasting in the traditional sense or by engaging in acts of kindness and penance. Let this time be an opportunity for us to renew our commitment to our faith and to grow in love for God and our neighbors.

May the Blessed Virgin Mary, whose birth we celebrate, intercede for us and lead us ever closer to her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.
