VICAR'S MESSAGE

HOLY CHILDHOOD DAY - SUNDAY, JANUARY 26, 2025

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate Holy Childhood Day on January 26, we turn our attention to the precious children of our parish, especially those in grades one to four. We recognize the incredible gift of children in our families, Church, and society, and we reflect on the importance of their faith formation through the Church's mission, particularly the Holy Childhood Association (HCA), now often called the Missionary Childhood Association (MCA).

The History of the Holy Childhood Organization

The Holy Childhood Association was founded in 1843 by Bishop Charles de Forbin-Janson in France. His vision was to create a missionary organization that would allow children to help other children around the world. Initially, children prayed and contributed small financial offerings to support the spiritual and material needs of children in missionary territories. The Holy Childhood Association is now an integral part of the Pontifical Mission Societies and operates in many countries, continuing its mission of teaching children to grow in faith while helping others.

The Mission and Activities of Holy Childhood

The Holy Childhood Association has a twofold mission:

- 1. To help children develop a deep love for Jesus, a sense of missionary discipleship, and a global outlook on the Church.
- 2. To support children in need, especially in developing countries, by providing spiritual and material assistance.

Children participate in activities such as:

- Praying for children worldwide.
- Offering small sacrifices and donations to help less fortunate children.
- Learning about the missionary work of the Church.
- Participating in parish events, charity drives, and spiritual programs.

Advantages of Involving Children in Holy Childhood Activities

When children are part of the Holy Childhood Association, they grow in love for God and neighbor. It helps them:

- **1. Develop a Missionary Spirit:** They learn the value of selflessness and serving others, which fosters empathy and compassion.
- **2. Deepen Their Faith:** Through prayer and catechesis, children grow closer to Jesus and the teachings of the Church.

- **4. Learn Responsibility:** By contributing their time and resources, they understand the importance of stewardship.

Faith Formation through Pious Associations

The Church provides many pious associations like the Holy Childhood to guide children in the faith from a young age. These associations lay a strong foundation for children to grow into mature Catholics who can courageously live out their faith. The earlier children are introduced to a Christ-centered life, the more likely they are to remain active in their faith as they grow. Such associations also complement family efforts in teaching morals, values, and spirituality.

How Jesus Valued Children and Childlikeness

Throughout His ministry, Jesus showed His special love for children. In Matthew 19:14, Jesus said: "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Jesus praised the innocence, humility, and trust of children and encouraged all His followers to embrace a childlike attitude in their faith. When we nurture the spiritual lives of our children, we are following Jesus' example of placing them at the heart of His ministry.

Parents as Role Models and Encouragers

Parents are the first and primary catechists for their children. The faith that children develop is often shaped by what they see and experience at home. Parents should model a life of prayer, regular Mass attendance, charity, and love for the Church. St. John Paul II reminded parents that their role in faith formation is "irreplaceable."

Encourage your children to participate in the parish's Holy Childhood activities, Mass, sacraments, and other Church events. Show them that being involved in the Church is a joyful and meaningful part of life. By doing this, you are fostering their love for God and building a strong foundation for their spiritual journey.

Advantages of Active Involvement of Children in Parish Activities

- **1. Builds Strong Faith Communities:** Children feel a sense of belonging and responsibility within the parish.
- **2. Develops Leadership Skills:** Early involvement helps them grow into future leaders in the Church.




