

VICAR'S MESSAGE

THE THREE-DAY FAST - A CALL TO REPENTANCE AND RENEWAL

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach the sacred season of Lent, the Syro-Malabar Church invites us to partake in a profound spiritual tradition: the **Three-Day Fast**, also known as the **Rogation of the Ninevites (Sleeva Nombu).** This year the fast is from February 10-12. These three days of fasting, prayer, and penance, inspired by the story of the people of Nineveh, offer us a unique opportunity to reflect deeply on God's boundless mercy and our need for repentance.

A Biblical Call to Conversion

The story of the Ninevites from the Book of Jonah is both humbling and inspiring. When Jonah proclaimed God's warning of destruction, the entire city of Nineveh responded with an open heart. From the king to the lowliest citizen, they fasted, prayed, and turned away from their sinful ways. Their heartfelt repentance moved God to spare them from destruction (Jonah 3:1–10).

Their example reminds us of a vital truth: **God is always merciful, slow to anger, and rich in kindness**. When we acknowledge our failures, humble ourselves before Him, and seek His forgiveness, He draws us back into His loving embrace.

Our Journey of Repentance

During these three days, the Church calls us to echo the spirit of the Ninevites in our own lives. This is not just a time of external fasting but a time of **internal transformation** - a time to ask ourselves:

- Where do I stand in my relationship with God?
- Have I allowed pride, selfishness, or indifference to separate me from His love?
- How can I better reflect His love in my life and to those around me?

Through prayer, fasting, and acts of charity, we can respond to this call for renewal. Let this time be a sacred pause in our busy lives, a chance to quiet our hearts and listen to God speaking to us.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

A Time of Spiritual Preparation

The Three-Day Fast is more than a tradition; it is a spiritual preparation for the holy season of Lent. It is a reminder that repentance is not an occasional event but an ongoing journey. As Jesus said, "Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand" (Matthew 4:17). Let us take these days seriously, offering our sacrifices and prayers as a sign of our commitment to turn back to the Lord with all our hearts.

Practical Ways to Observe the Three-Day Fast

- Participate in the Holy Qurbana (Mass): The Eucharist is the heart of our spiritual life. Attend Mass daily during these three days to receive grace and strength for your journey.
- Fasting and Abstinence: Practice voluntary self-denial by fasting and avoiding meat or other luxuries. This small sacrifice unites us with Christ's suffering and reminds us of our dependence on God.
- **Prayer and Reflection:** Spend time in personal and family prayer. Reflect on the Word of God, particularly the story of Jonah and the call to repentance.
- Acts of Charity: Reach out to those in need, whether through material support, kind words, or prayers.

God's Mercy Awaits

My dear friends, let us approach this fast with open hearts and a spirit of trust in God's love. The Ninevites were spared because they humbled themselves and sincerely sought God's mercy. Likewise, when we turn to Him in true repentance, He renews our hearts, restores our souls, and fills us with His grace.

May these days of fasting help us to grow closer to God and prepare us to enter the Lenten season with hearts renewed and ready to follow Him. Together, let us seek the Lord with contrite hearts, confident in the words of Psalm 51: "A broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise."

Let us journey together, as a family of faith, toward the mercy and love of God.


