VICAR'S MESSAGE

THE IMPORTANCE OF A POSITIVE APPROACH IN LIFE

How we approach these situations - whether with optimism or pessimism - can shape not only our own lives but also those of our families, parishes, and communities. A positive approach leads to growth, healing, and transformation, while a negative mindset can bring despair, division, and destruction. Today, let us reflect on the power of a positive approach in light of our Christian faith.

World-Changers: Optimists vs. Pessimists

Throughout history, great personalities have made a significant impact based on their outlook on life. Consider two contrasting perspectives:

- Optimistic Leaders: Mahatma Gandhi, Nelson Mandela, and Mother Teresa faced immense difficulties, yet their unwavering faith and positive mindset changed the world for the better. They believed in the goodness of humanity and worked tirelessly to bring justice, peace, and love.
- **Pessimistic Thinkers:** On the other hand, history has also seen leaders consumed by doubt, fear, and negativity. Their pessimism led to destructive decisions, harming themselves and their people. A negative approach often results in hopelessness, conflict, and failure.

Jesus: The Ultimate Role Model for Positivity






