

VICAR'S MESSAGE

PREPARING OUR HEARTS FOR THE SEASON OF GREAT LENT

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter the sacred season of Great Lent, the Holy Church invites us to a time of deep reflection, repentance, and renewal. Lent is a precious gift that allows us to walk with Christ in His suffering, purify our hearts, and grow closer to God. It is time to examine our spiritual life and make sincere efforts to renew our faith.

What is Lent and Why is it Important?

Lent is a 50-day period of fasting, prayer, and penance observed by the Syro-Malabar Church in preparation for the great feast of Easter. It is a season of spiritual discipline that reminds us of Jesus' 40 days of fasting in the wilderness and 10 days of reflecting on His ultimate sacrifice for our salvation. By observing Lent, we deepen our relationship with God and open our hearts to His grace.

How Do We Observe Lent?

Lent is observed through fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. We are encouraged to practice self-denial, control our desires, and grow in holiness. The Church calls us to spend more time in personal and family prayer, meditate on the Word of God, and engage in acts of charity. The faithful are also urged to attend Holy Qurbana regularly, receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and participate in the Lenten devotions.

Why Do We Begin Lent with the Penitential Service and the Imposition of Ashes?

Lent begins with a Penitential Service where we examine our conscience and seek forgiveness from God and one another. The imposition of ashes on Ash Monday (for the Syro-Malabar Church) is a powerful reminder of our mortality and our need for repentance: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return" (Genesis 3:19). This sacred tradition invites us to humble ourselves before God and start the season of Lent with a contrite heart.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

Why Does the Syro-Malabar Church Observe Ash Monday Instead of Ash Wednesday?

The Syro-Malabar Church follows the ancient Eastern tradition of beginning Lent on Ash Monday, allowing for a full 50-day preparation before Easter. This practice is rooted in the early traditions of the Eastern Churches, emphasizing the spiritual significance of a complete period of fasting and prayer leading to the Resurrection of Christ.

The Importance of Retreat, Confession, and Acts of Charity During Lent

Annual retreats are a great opportunity to renew our faith and encounter God more deeply. The Sacrament of Reconciliation cleanses our souls and restores our relationship with God and one another. Acts of charity - helping the poor, forgiving others, and showing kindness – reflect the true spirit of Lent. By engaging in these practices, we align our lives with the teachings of Christ.

Observing the Stations of the Cross on Fridays

Every Friday of Lent, the Church invites us to meditate on the Stations of the Cross, walking with Jesus on His journey to Calvary. This devotion helps us reflect on Christ's immense love and sacrifice, inspiring us to carry our own crosses with faith and patience.

A Call to Spiritual Renewal and Self-Discipline

Lent is not just about external practices; it is about transforming our hearts. It is a time to discipline our minds, bodies, and souls, turning away from sin and growing in holiness. By deepening our prayer life, fasting from sinful habits, and performing acts of love, we allow Christ to renew us from within.

Let us embrace this Lenten season with sincerity, seeking God's mercy and grace. May our journey through Lent lead us to the joy of Easter, where we will celebrate the victory of Christ over sin and death.

ABSTINENCE AND FAST

Ash Monday and Passion (Good) Friday are days of abstinence and fast. Meat is to be avoided every Friday of lent.

ANNUAL RETREAT

The annual Lenten Retreat of our parish will be held for adults from April 4 to 6 and for youth and children from April 5 to 6, 2025. Confession day will be on Saturday, April 5. We will have special prayers for the success of the retreat during the Lenten days form Sunday April 2, 2025. Please do the same at home during family prayer.

CONFESSION

Priests will be available to hear confession on every day before and after Holy Qurbana during the season of Lent.

HOLY COMMUNION IN DOUBLE SPECIES

We will start distributing Holy Communion in double species (in the form of bread and wine) during weekdays starting on Ash Monday. So, you have to receive the Holy Eucharist on your tongue.




