VICAR'S MESSAGE

THE FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH

Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate the feast of Saint Joseph, the Husband of Mary on March 19, we turn our hearts and minds to this silent yet powerful figure in the story of our salvation. St. Joseph, though chosen by God for a unique and honorable role, lived a life of humility, service, and unwavering trust in divine providence. His example continues to inspire us today in our personal, family, and professional lives.

A Model of Obedience and Righteousness

St. Joseph is described in the Scriptures as "a righteous man" (Mt 1:19). His righteousness was evident in his relationship with both God and those around him. When faced with the dilemma of Mary's unexpected pregnancy, he responded with compassion and integrity, choosing to protect her dignity rather than expose her to public shame. His quiet yet profound faith enabled him to embrace God's plan wholeheartedly. Even without a direct vision, but only through a dream, he believed the angel's message and took Mary as his wife, playing a crucial role in the unfolding of God's redemption.

His righteousness extended beyond this moment. As a faithful Jew, Joseph observed the laws and customs of his faith. He ensured that Jesus was circumcised on the eighth day (Lk 2:21) and presented at the Temple according to Mosaic Law (Lk 2:22-24). He also took his family to Jerusalem annually for the Feast of Passover (Lk 2:41), an obligation not required for those living far from Jerusalem. His faithfulness to Jewish traditions ensured that Jesus grew up in a household that honored God's law.

A Silent Servant of God

Despite being entrusted with the care of Jesus, the Son of God, the Bible does not record a single spoken word from Joseph. His actions, however, speak volumes. In his silent obedience, he teaches us that holiness is not found in seeking recognition but in faithfully fulfilling God's will. His humility challenges us to serve selflessly in our own vocations - whether as parents, workers, or members of the Church - seeking not personal gain but the greater glory of God.

Joseph's silence does not indicate passivity. He was an active protector and provider, taking immediate action when guided by God. When warned in a dream of Herod's plan to kill the child Jesus, Joseph did not hesitate but fled to Egypt with Mary and Jesus (Mt 2:13-15). When the danger had passed, he obeyed another divine instruction and returned to Nazareth (Mt 2:19-23). These decisions were not easy, yet Joseph never questioned God's guidance. His responsiveness to divine direction is an example for us to listen attentively and act promptly on God's call in our lives.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

Protector of the Holy Family

Joseph's role as the guardian of the Holy Family exemplifies his deep love, dedication, and responsibility. Despite hardships, such as the journey to Bethlehem, the flight into Egypt, and the struggles of daily life as a carpenter, he provided and cared for Mary and Jesus with unwavering devotion. In our own lives, we too are called to protect and nurture our families, entrusting them to the care of this great saint.

Joseph was a man of hard work and simplicity. He labored as a carpenter to support his family, demonstrating the dignity of honest labor. This is why he is honored as the patron of workers. His example reminds us that our work, no matter how simple or ordinary, can be an offering to God when done with love and dedication.

Patron of a Holy Death

Saint Joseph is also honored as the patron of a happy death, as tradition holds that he passed away in the presence of Jesus and Mary. His peaceful departure reminds us to prepare our souls for the eternal journey by living a life of righteousness and faith. Many generations have invoked his name in their final moments, praying, "Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, be the companions of my soul." May this prayer be a source of comfort and hope for us all.

Devotion to St. Joseph

Although devotion to St. Joseph grew gradually in the Church, his patronage is now widely recognized. Pope Pius IX declared him Patron of the Universal Church in 1870. Pope Pius XII instituted the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1 to honor his role as a laborer. Pope Francis has especially encouraged devotion to St. Joseph, even adding his name to the Eucharistic Prayers of the Qubana. The image of the Sleeping St. Joseph, popularized by Pope Francis, reminds us of how God communicated with him in dreams. Many place their prayer intentions under the image, entrusting their needs to his intercession.

A Guide for Our Lives

As we celebrate this feast, let us take inspiration from St. Joseph's life:

- Live humbly in service to God and others.
- Trust in God's plan, even when faced with uncertainty.
- Be faithful to our responsibilities as protectors of our families and communities.
- Seek St. Joseph's intercession in our daily struggles, work, and journey towards heaven.
