VICAR'S MESSAGE

THE SACRED RHYTHM OF HOLY WEEK: WHY THE DATES ARE NEVER THE SAME?

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter Holy Week, beginning with the solemn yet triumphant celebration of **Palm Sunday**, we are drawn once more into the mystery of our Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. On this day, we commemorate Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, where He was greeted with palm branches and shouts of "Hosanna!" - a moment filled with both joy and prophetic anticipation.

Palm Sunday invites us to reflect deeply on the humility and mission of Christ, who chose the path of the Cross for our redemption. It is a reminder that Christian leadership, modeled on Jesus, is not about glory but about service, sacrifice, and love. Let us carry our spiritual palms with reverence, allowing them to become symbols of peace and transformation in our lives.

Why Does the Date of Holy Week Change Each Year?

Many people notice that the date of **Easter Sunday**, and therefore the entire **Holy Week**, changes every year. This is different from celebrations like **Christmas**, which always falls on December 25. So, why is that?

The reason lies in how the Church chooses the date for Easter. It doesn't follow the regular **solar calendar** (which is based on the Earth's orbit around the sun), like most of our civil holidays. Instead, Easter follows a system based on the **lunar calendar**, which tracks the phases of the moon.

Here's how it works:

- Easter is celebrated on the **first Sunday** after the **first full moon** that occurs **on or after the vernal (spring) equinox**, which is usually around **March 21**.
- This means Easter can fall as early as March 22 or as late as April 25.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

What is the Vernal (Spring) Equinox?

The **vernal equinox**, also called the **spring equinox**, happens every year around **March 20 or 21**. On this day, **day and night are almost equal in length** all over the world. That's because the **sun is positioned directly above the equator**, giving us about **12 hours of daylight and 12 hours of darkness**.

The word "equinox" comes from Latin: "aequus" (equal) and "nox" (night). So it literally means "equal night."

The vernal equinox marks the official beginning of spring in the northern hemisphere. It also plays a key role in how we calculate the date of Easter Sunday. According to Church tradition, Easter is celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon that occurs on or after the vernal equinox. This is why the date of Easter changes each year - it's not based on a fixed date like Christmas, but on a combination of astronomical events (the equinox and the moon phases).

This method of dating Easter was established by the **Council of Nicaea** in the year **325 AD**. The early Church leaders wanted Easter to be celebrated in close connection with the **Jewish feast of Passover**, because that's when Jesus was crucified and rose from the dead. The **Jewish calendar** is also based on lunar cycles, so using the moon to determine Easter helped keep this historical and theological link.

So, the date of **Easter changes each year** depending on the **moon's cycle**, and once Easter is set, all the key days of **Holy Week** - Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday - are scheduled accordingly. This is a beautiful aspect of our liturgical calendar, rooted in ancient tradition.

It's a beautiful reminder that the Church's calendar isn't just a routine of dates, but a way of entering into God's sacred time. It helps us spiritually journey with Christ through His Passion, Death, and Resurrection in a way that connects us with nature, history, and God's divine plan.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

Since Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection occurred during the Passover, the Church continues to honor that timing. As the spring equinox and the full moon change yearly, **Easter can fall anywhere between March 22 and April 25**, and the dates of Holy Week move accordingly.

Let this week not just be a recollection of history, but a living encounter with the love of Christ. May our hearts be renewed by His mercy and may we grow ever more faithful in following His example.

Wishing you all a prayerful Holy Week and a blessed Easter.






