

INFANT MARTYRS: VICTIMS OF FAMILY ISSUES

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are deeply saddened and disturbed by the tragic events in Kerala, where two mothers, overwhelmed by despair and family issues, took their own lives along with those of their innocent children. This heart-wrenching news challenges us profoundly, urging each of us to deeply reflect on the condition and strength of our family bonds.

These young, innocent children have become infant martyrs - victims caught in the turmoil of unhealthy family relationships. As a community rooted in faith and tradition, we must ask ourselves what steps we can take to prevent such tragedies in the future.

Family is the fundamental building block of our society and church. However, the pressures and complexities of modern life can strain family relationships, sometimes to devastating outcomes. This painful incident highlights the urgent need for all of us to reconsider and renew our commitments to our family members with love, compassion, understanding, and open communication.

It is in this spirit that "Bonding Families," a nonprofit organization, has been established within the Knanaya Catholic Region of the United States with its unit in the Archdiocese of Kottayam. Its mission is to nurture strong family relationships through preventive education, professional counseling, and emergency assistance to those in crisis. I encourage all families to engage actively with these supportive services. Married couples, especially younger families, are strongly encouraged to attend post-marriage courses offered by this organization along with Family Commission. These courses can equip you with skills and insights necessary to navigate the challenges of married life positively and productively.

As we approach the Feast of Divine Mercy, let us turn to our Merciful Lord, seeking healing, forgiveness, and strength. Just as Christ showers His mercy upon us despite our shortcomings, let us extend that same mercy and compassion to our family members. Let us pray fervently for the souls of these mothers and their beloved children, and let us commit ourselves anew to fostering healthier, more loving family environments.
