VICAR'S MESSAGE

THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS AND THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

FEAST DAYS: FRIDAY AND SATURDAY FOLLOWING THE OCTAVE OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week we celebrate two beautiful and deeply connected feasts in our Church: **The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** on Friday and **the Immaculate Heart of Mary** on Saturday. These feasts are not only a call to veneration but a profound invitation to immerse ourselves in the divine and maternal love that flows from these two hearts - burning with compassion, mercy, and sacrificial love.

1. The Pierced Heart of Christ: Love Made Visible

In the Gospel of John (19:30–37), we reflect upon the moment when a Roman soldier pierced the side of our crucified Lord. From that pierced side flowed **blood and water** - symbols of **Baptism** and the **Holy Eucharist** - the two foundational sacraments that give life to the Church. This moment is not just a medical confirmation of Jesus' death but a spiritual revelation of his boundless love. He gave not only his life but every drop of his blood for our salvation.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, confirmed by the visions of **St. Margaret Mary Alacoque**, reveals the deep, aching love of Jesus for each of us. The Sacred Heart, often depicted as wounded, crowned with thorns, aflame with divine love, and shining with heavenly light, is a symbol of his mercy and invitation to conversion. Jesus himself asked that this feast be celebrated on the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi - linking the **Eucharistic sacrifice** with the **sacrifice of his heart**. Let us remember: this is not merely a devotion to an anatomical heart but to the depth of **divine agape** - unconditional, forgiving, and redemptive love.

2. The Immaculate Heart of Mary: A Mother's Loving Response

The Church beautifully celebrates the **Immaculate Heart of Mary** the very next day. Just as the Sacred Heart reveals God's love poured out, Mary's Immaculate Heart reflects her perfect response to that love. At the foot of the Cross, Mary united her suffering with that of her Son, silently offering her heart to the will of the Father.

It was from Mary's own heart and body that Jesus received his Sacred Heart. Her "yes" at the Annunciation and her unwavering faith at Calvary make her the perfect model of discipleship and maternal intercession. Pope Pius XII wrote that the Immaculate Heart of Mary is a symbol of her interior life: "her joys and sorrows, her virtues and hidden perfections, and, above all, her virginal love for God and her maternal love for her divine Son and all of us." Let us seek her intercession to help us open our own hearts to Christ.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

3. A Call to Live the Devotion

Devotion is not just about prayer or veneration - it is about **transformation**. The First Friday Devotion and daily acts of love and sacrifice in honor of the Sacred Heart are meant to form us into more merciful and compassionate people.

Jesus taught us to **forgive our enemies, to love sacrificially, and to seek the lost**. Even Longinus, the centurion who pierced Jesus' heart, according to tradition became a saint. This is the power of divine love - it transforms persecutors into witnesses, strangers into saints.

Let us renew our devotion to the Sacred Heart through:

- Frequent participation in the Holy Qurbana and Adoration
- Practicing First Friday Devotion in reparation for sins
- Acts of mercy and forgiveness toward those who wrong us
- Daily consecration of ourselves and our families to the Sacred and Immaculate Hearts

4. Let the Flame of Love Burn in Us


As St. John the Evangelist, the beloved disciple who leaned on the chest of Jesus, testified: "God is love, and whoever remains in love remains in God and God in him (1 Jn 4:16). The hearts of Jesus and Mary are a perpetual invitation to rest our hearts in theirs.

May this week's celebration inflame in us a greater love for Jesus and his Mother. May we imitate their love, and allow our families and parish to be places where the Heart of Christ reigns and the Heart of Mary guides.
