


### VICAR'S MESSAGE

#### FEAST OF DUKHRANA (REMEMBRANCE) OF ST. THOMAS THE APOSTLE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Warm greetings in the name of our Risen Lord!

On July 3rd, we celebrate the **Dukhrana of St. Thomas the Apostle**, a solemn remembrance of the life, faith, missionary zeal, and martyrdom of the Apostle who brought the light of Christ to our land. As Knanaya Catholics and as Christians in India, this day holds special meaning for us. It is not just a feast, but a tribute to the apostolic foundation of our faith.

St. Thomas, also known as **Mar Thoma Sleeha**, was one of the twelve apostles who followed Jesus with profound commitment and personal courage. His bold proclamation - "**Let us also go to die with him" (Jn 11:16)** - is a testimony to his deep love for the Lord. Though he had moments of doubt, his final declaration - "**My Lord and my God!" (Jn 20:28)** - has become the cornerstone of our faith in the divinity of Christ.

Despite being labelled a "doubter," Thomas was in fact a curious learner, a convinced believer, and ultimately a fearless missionary. After receiving the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, he courageously ventured outside the Roman Empire, bringing the gospel to Parthia, Persia, and India, and possibly even China and Japan according to some traditions. It was here in India, starting from Kodungalloor, that he baptized many, established seven and a half churches, and laid the spiritual foundation of Christian life that continues to flourish to this day.

One of the most moving aspects of his life is how **Thomas used his profession as a builder** - both literally and spiritually - to construct the Church. He did not build palaces for kings on earth but chose instead to build heavenly homes for souls by preaching the gospel and helping the poor. His example reminds us to **invest in treasures that last eternally** (cf. Mt 6:20).

Thomas' mission eventually led him to **martyrdom at St. Thomas Mount in Mylapore**, sealing his testimony with blood. His relics, originally buried in India, were later transferred to Edessa and parts of Europe, yet his memory and mission remain deeply rooted in our land and in our hearts.

Let us draw five key lessons from the life of this great apostle:

- 1. **Courage in Faith:** Like Thomas, let us be bold in professing our faith in Christ even in difficult times, standing firm in the face of opposition or fear.
- 2. **Follow the Way:** Thomas prompted Jesus to reveal that He is "the Way, the Truth, and the Life." Let us faithfully walk this way, which leads to the Father.
- 3. **Remain in Fellowship:** Even when faith is tested, never isolate yourself from the believing community. Like Thomas, remain in prayer and communion until you encounter the Lord again.

- 4. **Build Heavenly Homes:** Let us be wise stewards of our blessings, using our time, talents, and resources to build God's kingdom rather than earthly glory.
- 5. **Honor the Blessed Mother:** Tradition holds that Thomas was privileged to witness Mary's Assumption. May we, too, turn to our Blessed Mother for her intercession and guidance toward heaven.


As we celebrate this **Dukhrana**, let it be not just a memory, but a renewal of our **apostolic identity**, especially as Knanaya Catholics who trace our roots to the Chaldean Church in Edessa that had a strong connection with St. Thomas himself. May his faith inspire our families, his courage strengthen our youth, and his intercession accompany us on our journey of discipleship.
