

VICAR'S MESSAGE

HONORING VENERABLE MAR MATHEW MAKIL

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With great joy and gratitude to God, I wish to share the historic and spiritually uplifting news that Bishop Mar Mathew Makil, the former Vicar Apostolic of Changanacherry and the founder of the Knanaya Catholic hierarchy, was officially declared Venerable on July 26, 2025, at Kottayam.

What Does It Mean to Be Venerable?

The title "Venerable" is the second step in the four-stage process of canonization in the Catholic Church. It is given to a person who has been found, after rigorous examination by the Vatican's Dicastery for the Causes of Saints, to have lived a life of "heroic virtue" — that is, a life marked by deep faith, hope, charity, humility, prudence, and pastoral zeal.

By this declaration, the Church recognizes that Mar Mathew Makil, though not yet beatified or canonized, has led a life worthy of emulation. However, at this stage, he is not yet entitled to public liturgical veneration like a "Blessed" or a "Saint."

Who Was Mar Matthew Makil?

Born in 1851 in Manjoor, Kerala, and ordained a priest in 1874, Mar Mathew Makil became the first indigenous bishop for the Syro-Malabar Church in Changanacherry, and later the founding bishop of the Knanaya Catholic Vicariate in 1911. He served his people with outstanding pastoral care, deep spirituality, and an unwavering commitment to the unity of the Church. He played a significant role in strengthening Catholic identity and discipline among the Knanaya faithful.

His virtuous life, humility, and visionary leadership continue to inspire generations.

What Can the Faithful Do Now?

- **Pray through his intercession:** Though not yet canonized, the faithful may privately ask for the intercession of Venerable Mar Mathew Makil, especially for spiritual needs and healing. If a miracle is attributed to his intercession and validated by the Church, it may lead to beatification the next step in the process.
- **Study his life and virtues:** Let us read about his legacy and reflect on how we can imitate his virtues in our families, parishes, and communities.
- **Promote devotion with discretion:** While public liturgical celebrations in his name are not yet permitted, private devotions and prayers are encouraged as a way to grow in holiness and honor his memory.
- **Support the cause:** Pray for the successful advancement of his cause and support initiatives that promote awareness about his life and mission.






Conclusion


