

### VICAR'S MESSAGE

# THE BEAUTY OF SACRAMENTAL MARRIAGE AND THE DANGERS OF LIVING TOGETHER OUTSIDE IT

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's society, we increasingly see the trend of young people living together without the blessing of the Church—sometimes after a civil marriage, and often before any formal commitment. This is not a small issue. It is a spiritual and moral challenge that threatens the sanctity of marriage, family life, and even the salvation of souls.

#### 1. Catholic Understanding of Marriage

Marriage is not simply a social arrangement or private contract. It is a covenant established by God. Jesus said: "What God has joined together, let no one separate" (Matthew 19:6). Through the Sacrament of Matrimony, husband and wife receive God's grace to love faithfully, raise children, and reflect Christ's love for His Church.

Civil marriage alone, or cohabitation without marriage, lacks this sacramental grace. Such a union rests on human promises rather than God's blessing, leaving it fragile and vulnerable.

### 2. Dangers of Living Together and Premarital Sex

Though often portrayed as "freedom" or "modern living," living together and engaging in premarital sex bring serious dangers:

- **Grave Sin:** Sexual intimacy outside of sacramental marriage is a mortal sin, endangering the soul and cutting one off from the sacraments, especially Holy Communion.
- **Contraceptives:** Many who live together resort to contraceptives. The Church teaches that contraception distorts the sacred meaning of sexuality, which is meant for both love and openness to life. It often leads to treating the other as an object of pleasure rather than a gift from God.
- **Abortion:** When contraceptives fail or when a pregnancy occurs outside marriage, some resort to abortion. Abortion is the taking of innocent human life—a grave sin that brings deep spiritual, emotional, and psychological wounds.
- **Children Before Marriage:** The birth of children outside a Church-blessed marriage can cause instability, confusion, and emotional suffering for both parents and children, depriving them of the secure foundation of a sacramental family.
- **Emotional Distress:** Cohabitation often leads to heartbreak, mistrust, and a sense of being "used." Without a lifelong commitment before God, relationships often collapse under pressure.

### VICAR'S MESSAGE

• **Weakened Family and Faith:** Such practices undermine Christian family values, weaken the witness of the community, and mislead others, especially younger generations.

#### 3. A Call to Conversion and Renewal

The Church is not here to condemn but to heal and guide. To couples who are living together or have only a civil marriage: the Church warmly invites you to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony. God's grace strengthens love, heals wounds, and restores joy. Confession and reconciliation open the door to a new beginning.

#### 4. The Role of Parents and Catechism Teachers

- **Parents:** Speak openly to your children about chastity, God's plan for love, and the dangers of premarital sex, contraception, and abortion. Share your own witness of a faithful Catholic marriage.
- Catechism Teachers: Teach clearly and compassionately about the sacredness of sexuality and the sanctity of marriage. Encourage students to ask questions, but always lead them to God's truth rather than the world's false promises.
- **Community:** Let us celebrate marriages in the Church with joy, prepare our youth for holy family life, and accompany with mercy those who need to regularize their marriages.

#### 5. Conclusion

Dear young people, real love does not fear commitment. It waits patiently for the blessing of God through the sacrament of marriage. Cohabitation, premarital sex, and contraceptives may look like shortcuts to happiness, but they often end in sorrow, brokenness, and sin. Only God's way leads to lasting joy and eternal blessing.

Let us, as families and as a parish, teach and witness to the beauty of marriage as God intended it. Let us pray for our youth, that they may walk in holiness and discover true happiness in Christ.


