HALLOWEEN VS ALL SAINTS DAY

Dear Parish Family,

As we approach the beginning of November, our Church invites us to reflect deeply on two beautiful and meaningful feasts — All Saints' Day (November 1st) and All Souls' Day (November 2nd). These are not just dates on our liturgical calendar; they are sacred opportunities to remember who we are as Christians and where our ultimate home lies — in heaven with God and all His saints.

All Saints' Day celebrates all the holy men and women who have reached heaven — both those canonized by the Church and the countless others known only to God. They are our models of faith, courage, and love. Their lives remind us that holiness is not limited to priests or nuns; it is the universal call of every baptized Christian. We are all called to be saints through our daily lives of faith, hope, and charity.

All Souls' Day follows as a day of prayer and remembrance for all the faithful departed who are still being purified in purgatory. It is our sacred duty and privilege to pray for them, that they may quickly enjoy the eternal joy of heaven. This act of love reflects our belief in the Communion of Saints — the living, the departed, and the glorified — all united in Christ.

While society increasingly emphasizes **Halloween** with its secular and even anti-Christian elements, we as Catholics must return to the true meaning of these days. Halloween originally meant "All Hallows' Eve," the vigil of All Saints' Day. Sadly, its focus today has drifted toward fear, darkness, and trivialization of death. Instead, let us use this time to celebrate the light of Christ and the victory of holiness over evil.

To instill this Christian understanding in our younger generation, we are organizing a "Saints' Procession" next Sunday before the 9:30 A.M. Holy Qurbana. I invite all catechism students — especially our high school students — to learn about their patron saints and to dress like them as a sign of inspiration and devotion. This will be a joyful and faith-filled expression of our Catholic identity.

My sincere **appreciation to all parents** who encourage their children to take part in this Christian alternative to Halloween. By guiding your children toward the saints, you are leading them toward holiness and the path of heaven.


VICAR'S MESSAGE






