PASTOR'S MESSAGE

FEAST OF ST. SEBASTIAN, A DOUBLE MARTYR

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Next Sunday, our parish joyfully celebrates the Feast of Saint Sebastian, one of the most beloved martyrs of the universal Church and a saint held in deep devotion by our Kerala Christian tradition. The widespread churches dedicated in his name and the countless faithful who bear his name testify to the enduring impact of his heroic witness. Introduced to Kerala through European missionaries during times of deadly plagues, devotion to Saint Sebastian took deep root as people experienced his powerful intercession in moments of fear, sickness, and uncertainty.

Saint Sebastian's life is a striking witness to courageous faith lived in the ordinary structures of society. Born in Gaul and educated in Milan, he rose to prominence as an officer in the Roman imperial army, eventually serving in the Praetorian Guard under Emperor Diocletian. While outwardly a loyal soldier, he was inwardly a committed disciple of Christ. At a time when Christians were brutally persecuted, Sebastian used his position not for personal gain, but to secretly support imprisoned believers—bringing them comfort, strengthening their wavering faith, and encouraging them to remain faithful even unto martyrdom.

His life beautifully reveals the power of lay witness. In prisons and public service, Sebastian evangelized not by official preaching but by personal courage, charity, and conviction. Through his Spirit-filled exhortations and God's healing power working through him, many—including soldiers, prisoners, government officials, and their families—embraced the Christian faith and received Baptism. His life reminds us that the Gospel can transform hearts even in hostile environments when lived with integrity and boldness.

Sebastian's faith eventually came to light, leading to his arrest and cruel martyrdom. Bound to a tree and pierced with arrows, he was left for dead. Yet God granted him a miraculous survival, offering him a second chance—not to escape, but to confront the emperor once more with the truth of the Gospel. His second martyrdom, beaten to death with clubs, sealed his total self-gift to Christ. His body, reverently buried by the faithful, became a source of blessing and hope for generations.

Throughout history, the Church has experienced Saint Sebastian's powerful intercession, especially during times of plague and widespread illness. From Rome to Pavia, and later across Europe, devotion to him grew as people recognized God's mercy at work through his prayers. Thus, he became patron against plague and illness, and also of soldiers, police officers, athletes, and all who face danger in the service of others.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

As we celebrate his feast, Saint Sebastian speaks powerfully to our parish and to our times.

- 1. The Church has been nourished through the centuries by the sacrifice of Christ and the blood of martyrs. Saint Sebastian reminds us that the Church continues to grow when believers courageously witness to Christ through faith-filled lives, even amid trials.
- 2. Saint Sebastian stands as a shining model of lay ministry. Without abandoning his secular responsibilities, he transformed his workplace into a mission field. He reminds our lay faithful that evangelization is not limited to clergy and religious; every baptized person is called to be a witness to Christ in daily life.
- 3. While we confidently seek Saint Sebastian's intercession, we remember that all grace comes from God through Jesus Christ, the one Mediator. Our devotion to the saints must always deepen, never replace, our worship of God and our personal relationship with Christ.

May Saint Sebastian inspire our parish to be fearless in faith, generous in service, and steadfast in hope. Through his prayers, may our families and community be protected, strengthened, and renewed in the joy of the Gospel.

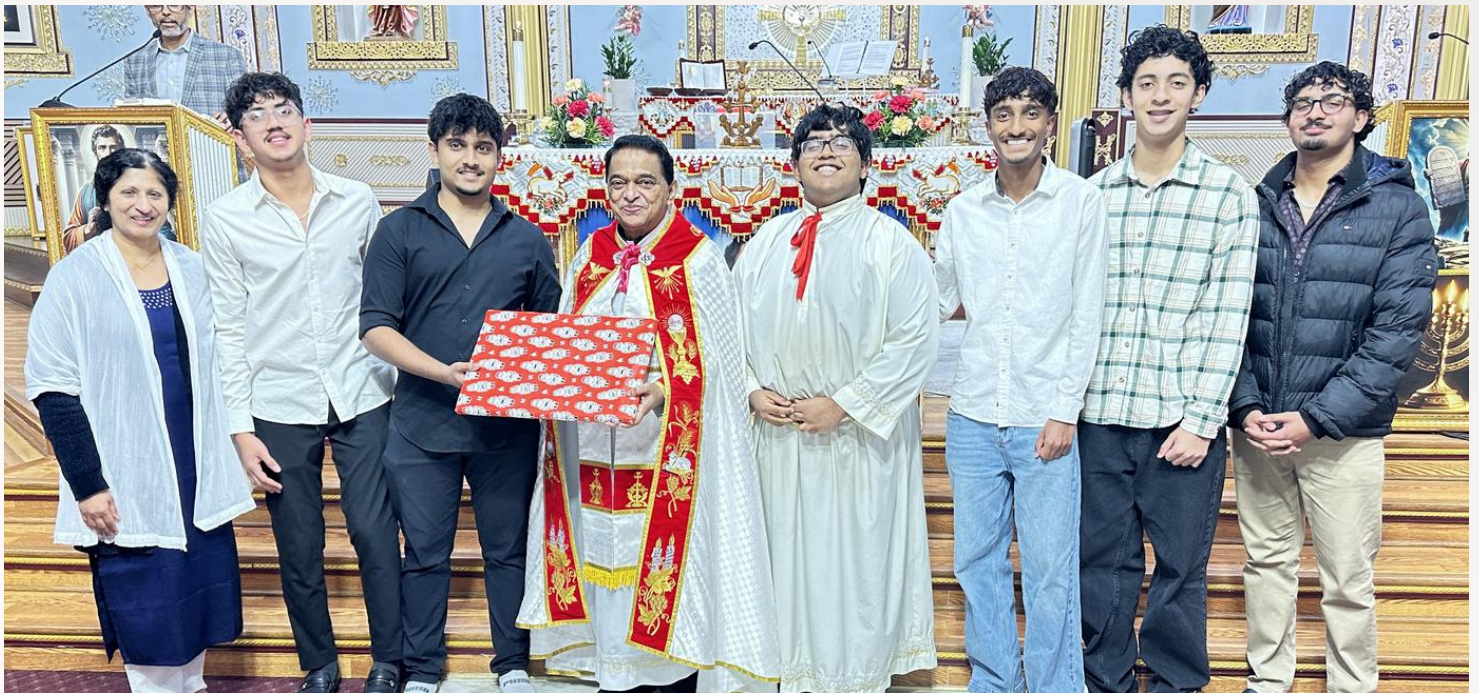

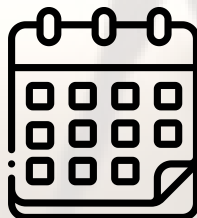

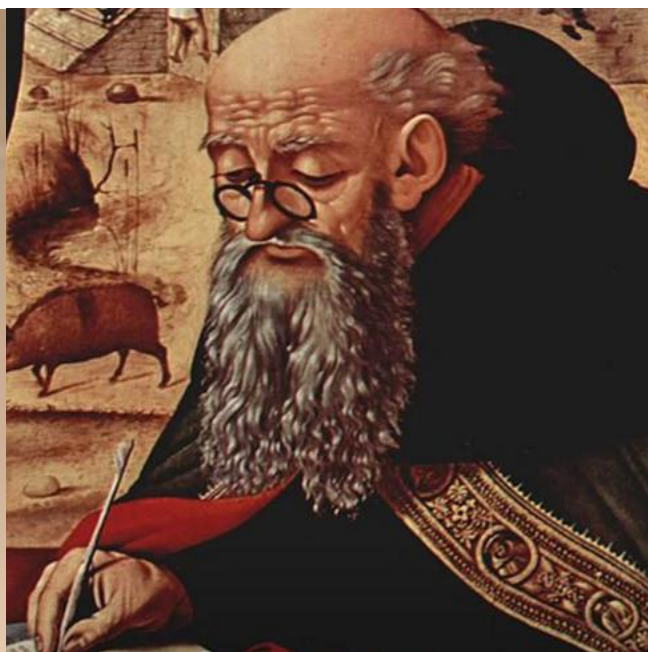
