

VICAR'S MESSAGE

GREAT LENT: A JOURNEY OF CONVERSION

Dearly beloved in Christ,

The Holy Church now invites us to enter the sacred Season of the Great Fast (Sauma Ramba), a privileged time of grace, conversion, and spiritual renewal. This holy season prepares us to celebrate the **Paschal Mystery**—the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ—which stands at the very heart of our salvation.

The Meaning and Structure of the Great Fast

The foundation of the Great Fast is the **forty-day fast of Jesus** in the wilderness, during which He prepared Himself for His public mission. To this, the Church adds **ten more days** in remembrance of the Passion of Christ, culminating in the joyful celebration of Easter. Thus, our tradition speaks of a **fifty-day fast**, faithfully observed by the St. Thomas Christians from **Pethurtha Sunday to Easter Sunday**. The Syriac word Pethurtha means “putting an end” or “turning back,” reminding us that days of excess and self-indulgence must give way to repentance, discipline, and renewed focus on God.

Milestones Along the Lenten Journey

On the **Wednesday of the fourth week**, the Church commemorates the **midpoint of the Great Fast**, calling us to examine our progress, correct our shortcomings, and recommit ourselves to the spirit of fasting and conversion.

The **40th day** marks the completion of the fast proper and the beginning of the intense **Passion observance**, drawing us ever closer to the saving sufferings of Christ.

A Call to Inner Conversion

Great Lent teaches us that an unchecked attachment to material wealth leads to sin. Wealth is God’s gift, entrusted to us to be used wisely and shared generously. True salvation is experienced through **repentance, prayer, fasting, and works of charity**. We become authentic disciples when we accept **God Himself as our true wealth**, following the example of the apostles who renounced everything to follow Christ.

Salvation is received when we humbly **confess our sins** and cast aside the dirty mantle of sin. Our sanctification is God’s will, and it is made possible only through **Jesus Christ**, who offered His Body and Blood to the Father for our sake. Though the body tempts us toward sin, resisting evil involves sacrifice and suffering. When we unite our sufferings with those of Christ, we grow in faith and are prepared to share in the **joy and peace of His Resurrection**.

Lenten Discipline and Catholic Practice

The Church designates **Ash Monday and Passion Friday** as days of fasting and abstinence. More broadly, Great Lent is a sacred season of conversion that calls for both **external discipline and interior transformation**.

VICAR'S MESSAGE

How We Observe Great Lent

- **Fasting:** A voluntary act of self-denial that disciplines the body and deepens our hunger for God, especially observed on Ash Monday and Good Friday, and practiced personally throughout Lent.
- **Abstinence:** Particularly from meat on Fridays, uniting us with Christ's sacrifice and fostering simplicity and self-control.
- **Way of the Cross:** By meditating on the Stations of the Cross, we enter into the Lord's Passion and learn to carry our own crosses with hope.
- **Holy Qurbana:** Participation in the Eucharist is central to Lenten life, strengthening us with Christ Himself.
- **Lenten Retreats and Spiritual Exercises:** Times of silence and reflection that renew our commitment to the Gospel.
- **Confession (Sacrament of Reconciliation):** At the heart of Lent, restoring us to grace through God's mercy and forgiveness.

Pastoral Guidance on Fasting and Abstinence

The Church binds the faithful to fasting and abstinence while recognizing human limitations. Exemptions are granted based on **age, health, and serious circumstances**, and those exempt are encouraged to observe Lent through prayer, charity, and suitable self-denial. The Church reminds us that God does not desire penance that harms the person; true Lenten observance is a sincere **turning of the heart toward God** (cf. CCC 1430–1432).

Conclusion

Dear brothers and sisters, the practices of Great Lent are not ends in themselves. They are sacred means that lead us to genuine conversion—helping us love God more deeply, turn away from sin, and live more fully as disciples of Christ. May this Great Fast be a blessed journey that draws us closer to the Cross and prepares us to rejoice in the glory of the Resurrection.

May the Lord grant us the grace to walk this holy path faithfully and fruitfully.



- It has come to the attention of the Parish Council that during recent Sunday collections, several counterfeit "movie prop" \$100 bills have been discovered in the offertory baskets. To ensure proper handling, the parish trustees have used protective gloves while securing these notes, so that any necessary fingerprint detection may be preserved for official investigation.


